These conferences & competitions are usually held in a specific zone or state and hence travelling hinders the participation of students to the maximum. The covid coming up with the lockdown worldwide has obviously not been soo bad to be blamed, as along with it came the opportunities of attending these summits online from the ease of our own locations.

Students of grade 11 attended the International Adolescent Summit along with 14000 more participating schools from all over the world. It was a monthlong event with different competitions and workshops organised by the Expressions India Guild. Samruddhi Jha, Grade 11 was an orator speaking for "the need to focus on the influence of Social media on children". Dhvani Marthak and Preity Patil's (Grade 11) paintings found its place in the Day 5 of the summits display of posters on "child abuse and






