Physics: RESEARCH PROJECTS: (Any two)

1. The principle of reflection of sound is used in an instrument called the SONAR which is used to find the depth of the sea at any place. A SONAR produces ultrasonic pulses which are sent down into the sea from a ship. they are received back after being reflected by the bottom of the sea. The depth of the sea is calculated by measuring the time taken by the echo to be received.

Find out the full form of SONAR.

Find out how bats use this technique to see at night and to detect and catch insects.

2. What is Earthquake? How the intensity of earthquake is measured? What are the main causes of earthquake? What are the effects of earthquake? What precautions are taken against earthquake?

3. Semiconductors are extremely useful in the field of electronics. Find out the name of the semiconductor that is most commonly used in making electronic devices. Find out how solar cells are made from this semiconductor. find out how very small electronic components, which have made it possible to produce the small computers used today, are made from it.

4. GPS is a system of several satellites used for all kinds of navigation- even in a car travelling in a city. It can tell the exact latitude, longitude and altitude of the place a person is located in. Find out the full form of GPS and how it works.
