students basked in the sun as they stretched and dived in the playgrounds. Catch a glimpse of how we continued maintaining social distancing and allowed the children to be one with nature.

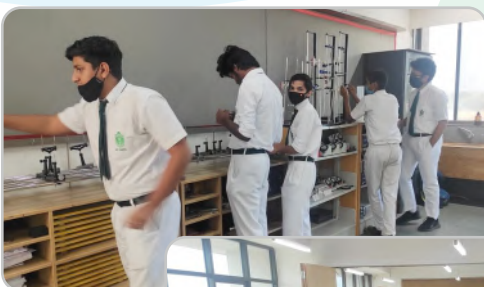
ROLE PLAY

presents a variety of options for management to consider when making technology infrastructure decisions, recognizing that circumstances and context vary greatly from child to child.

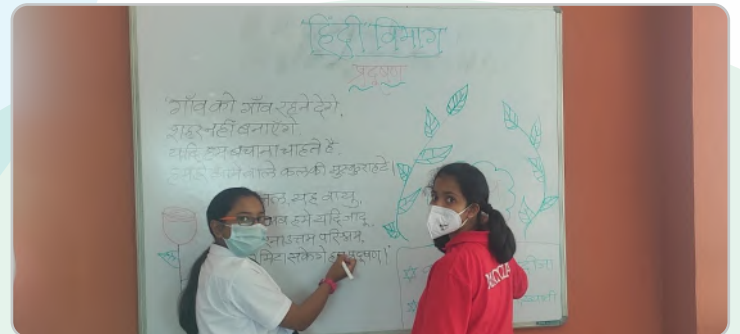

As the country celebrates its 75th Independence schools have geared up to prepare for activities to instill in our students the essence of freedom and value the

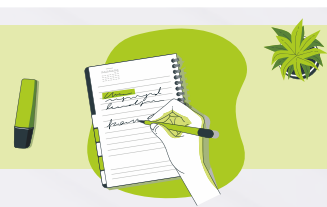
sacrifice made by the freedom fighters .It's also a time when we will be able to educate the present generation to value our culture and heritage.

FOOD DESIGNING COURSE

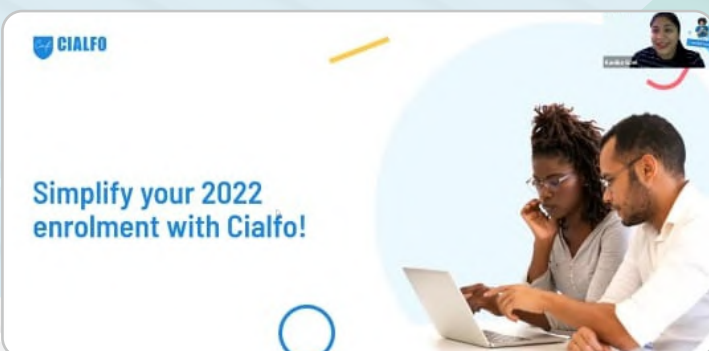

CYBER SECURITY SESSION



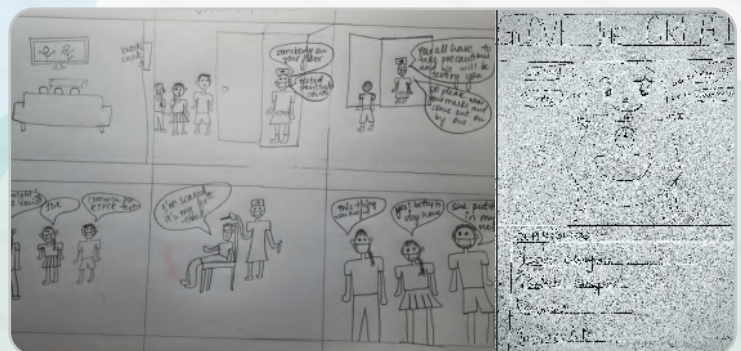

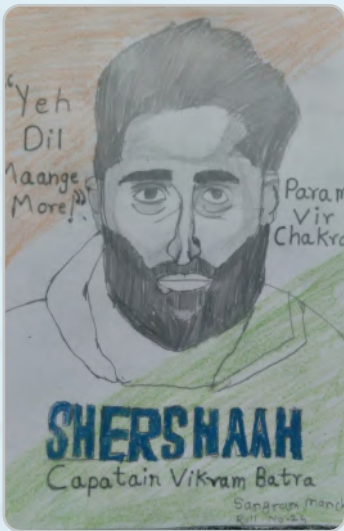

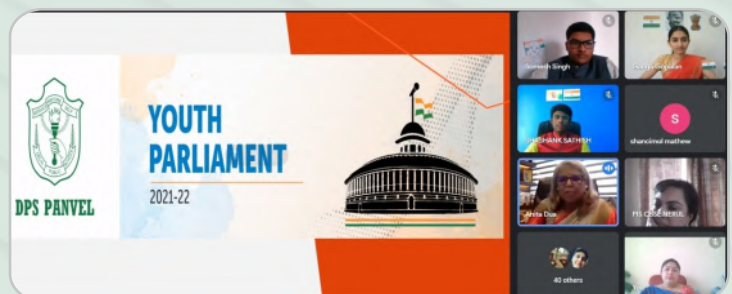
INTERSCHOOL SINGING COMPETITION
