TOY MAKING COMPETITION (CLASS III TO VIII)

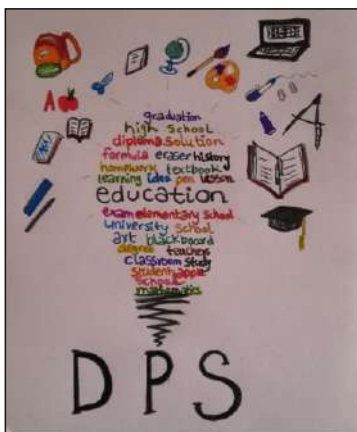
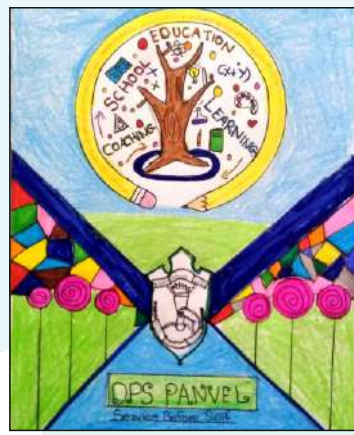

DPS HOWRAH - VIRASAT LITERARY FEST

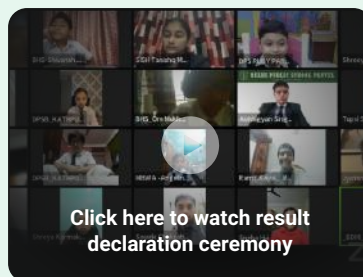

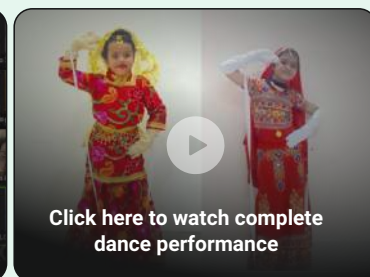

ART AND CRAFT

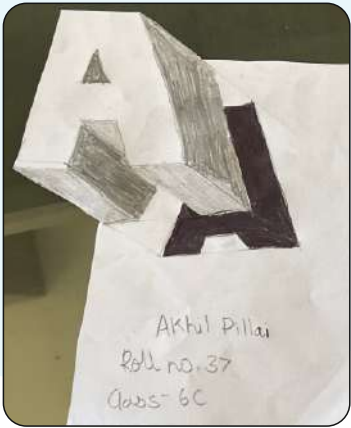

everybody on a trip down childhood memories, filled with fun, frolic, dance and laughter.

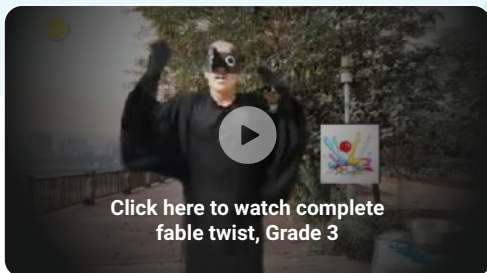

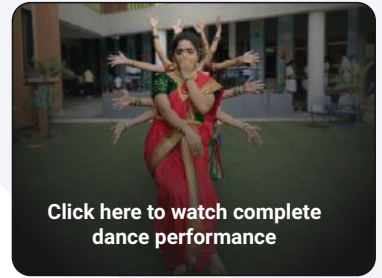
SECONDARY & SENIOR SECONDARY
