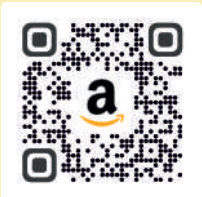

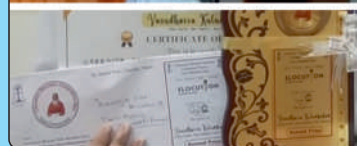

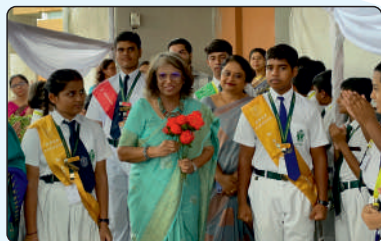

relaxing and rejuvenating.

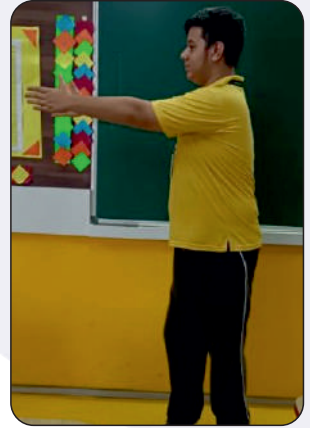
The session began with students attending lecture with complete interest, enthusiasm. They did a series of asanas to warm up and stretch. Next every individual was asked to perform the yoga

## RAKSHA BANDHAN CELEBRATION

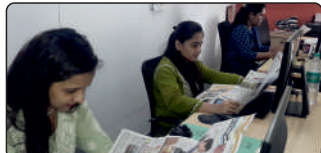
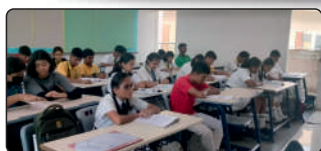


“Raksha Bandhan is not just a thread; it's love that forever connects our hearts.”
