ART AND CRAFT

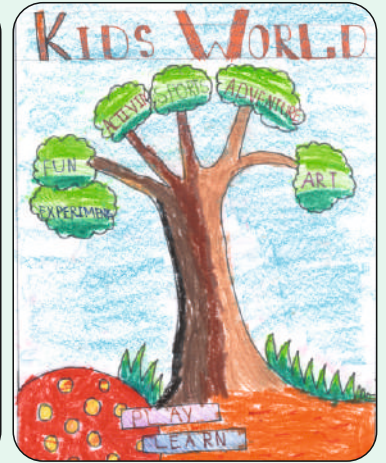
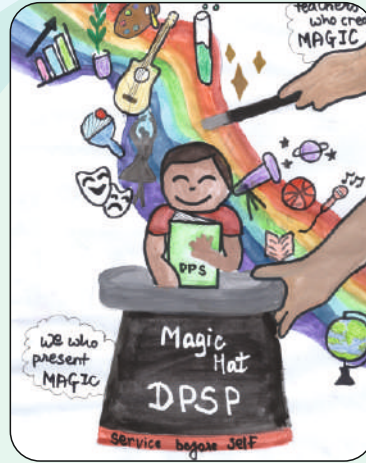
DPS Panvel fosters individuality in students through art, creating an environment that encourages appreciation of various forms of art. The faculty is highly skilled and passionate, inspiring students
