## PARENTS TALK



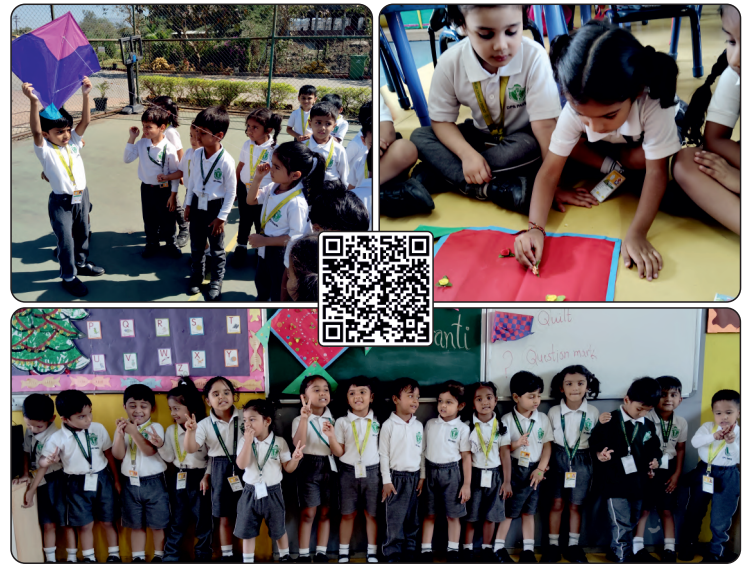
