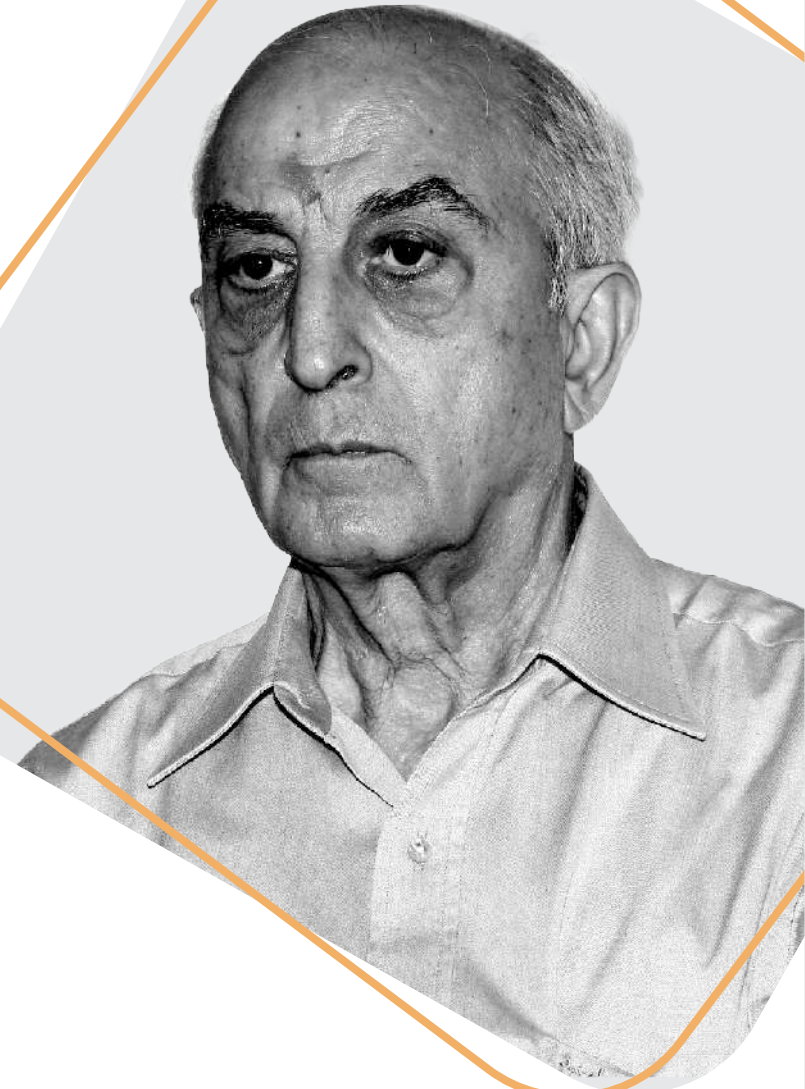



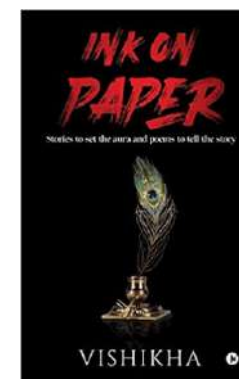

Students become lifelong learners who make lasting contributions to the world. They develop the habits of the mind that enable them to think critically, solve problems, empathize, create and make our world better.

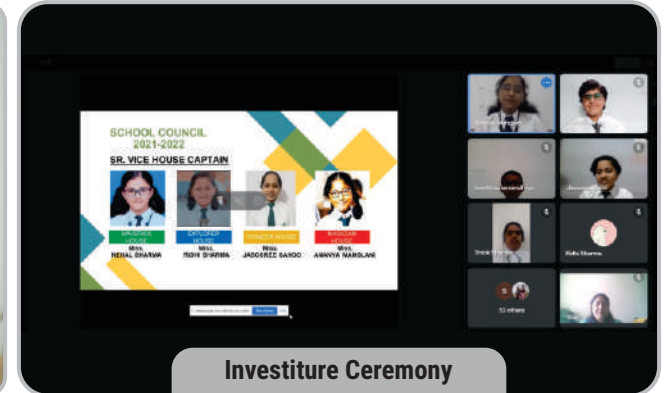

Consider admission criteria of colleges

The CBSE has introduced a moderation policy for schools so that the marking is standardised for Class 10 board results. This also considers the performance of the child in grade 9. A year-long performance data should be taken into consideration as it will give candidates the recognition they deserve for their overall development.

The board should give weightage to Class 12 internal examinations /assessments/practical exams along with the teacher's observations and recommendations which is



usually unbiased. The board might consider varying factors while coming up with the objective criteria for deciding Class 12 results, keeping in mind further admission criterion for students opting for foreign universities and courses. Some schools may have already conducted Class 12 pre-board exams while other might not have.

to build life-long autonomous learners who not only have enough clarity on the subjects they choose, but also have the astuteness to put the knowledge to best use in real life situations.

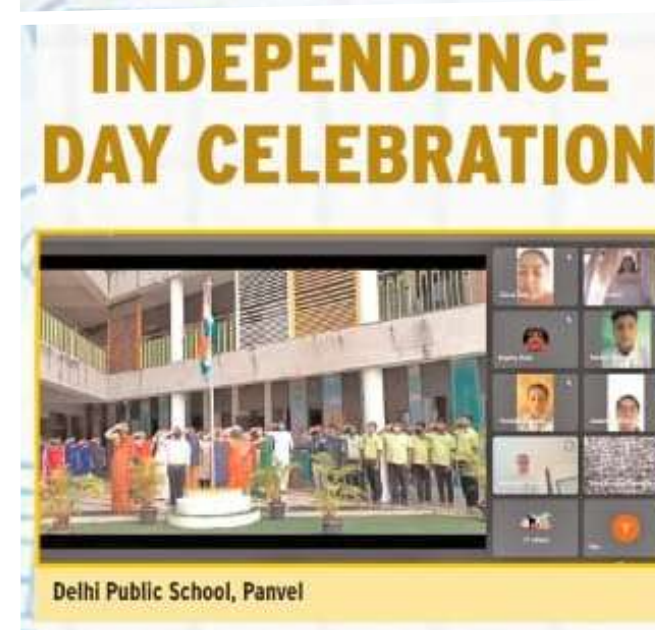

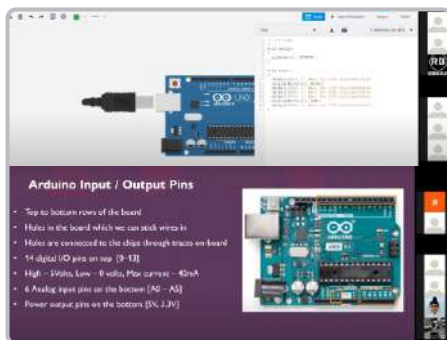

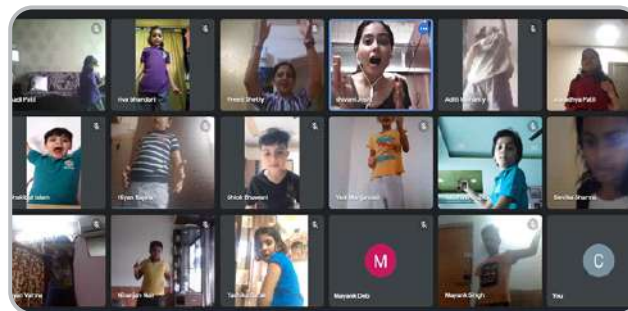

Webinars

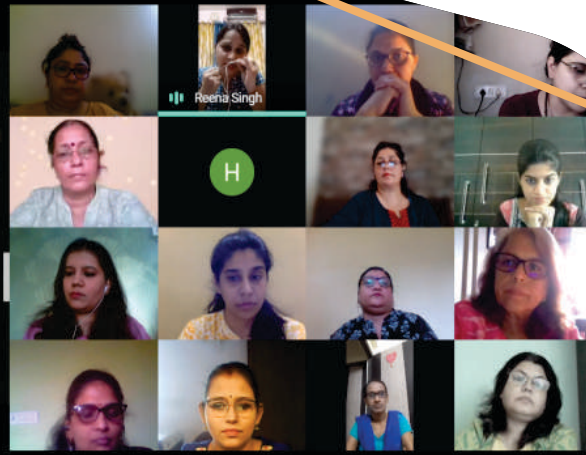

The minimum age for admission in Nursery, KG 1, KG 2 and class 1 is being fixed as follows:
